Orkney Springs: The restored, historic, 3 story hotel is on the left. Parking area is beyond the hotel. Registration is in the hotel lobby.



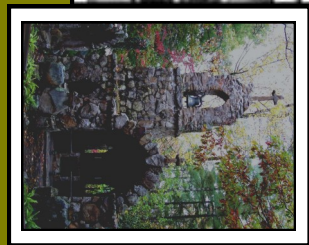

The Healing Center at Orkney Springs -Conceived in 1985 out of a vision given to our beloved friend, the late Dr. Bill Reed. He stated that Orkney Springs has a rich heritage as a place of healing. Indians brought their sick to the natural springs located here. The restored, three-story hotel was used as a confederate hospital during the Civil War. Episcopal Bishop Gibson ministered healing to many people through his years of service here. His son-in-law Dr. Woodward, physician and missionary to China, continued on and expanded the Shrine Mont/ Orkney Springs vision. As a retreat center for the Episcopal Church, and also used by many other denominations, Orkney Springs is especially known as a place of prayer. In 1991, God brought forth the beginning of this vision as teaching and healing conferences: encouraging, refreshing, discipling and equipping lay people, pastors, physicians, nurses, counselors, and others to receive and minister Christ Jesus' salvation and healing. God desires to manifest unity in His body by bringing lay people, pastors, and medical professionals together to learn from Him through each other how to minister the fullness of God's healing to the whole person.

Dr. Reed went to be with Our Lord on 12/28/2010. He is missed dearly by his colleagues and friends at The Healing Center who will forever be blessed by his vision.

Philip Dunn was born in Charleston WV, where he is currently Senior Pastor of Valley Christian Assembly. He attended South Eastern Bible College in Lakeland FL where he met Suzette, his wife. They have two children, David and Sarah, & four grandchildren.

After being diagnosed with bilateral cataracts and macular degeneration, Pastor Philip experienced 14 years of “illegal” blindness. In 2018, he had surgery on a ruptured cataract, and in addition, the black spots in his vision were gone. The story was picked up by ABC World News in 2019. FYI - Google “Philip Dunn blind”.

Dr. Jim Caudill a board-certified Ophthalmologist in private practice in Charleston, WV from 1985 until retirement in 2021. He has been on over 25 short-term mission trips in Mexico, Central, and South America for cataract surgery and other eye care. He performed Rev. Philip’s surgery.

He is married to Gloriann, & they have four adult children, Steve, Cathy, Carol & Diane. Dr. Caudill & Pastor Dunn met while serving with Kairos Prison Ministry.
